



Silpakorn University Announcement
On Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Presents and Gifts
From Performing Duties “No Gift Policy”

In order to express the intention to oppose all forms of corruption and misconduct, executives, civil officials, personnel and employees of Silpakorn University shall refrain from accepting all kinds of presents and gifts that will result in corruption and misconduct both at present and in the future, in accordance with the National Reformation Program (revision) on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (Activity 4: to develop the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and non-beneficial) which requires all government agencies to declare that they are an agency whose every government official does not accept all kinds of presents and gifts from performing duties (No Gift Policy). Moreover, Silpakorn University has announced the Silpakorn University Announcement on Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Presents and Gifts from Performing Duties "No Gift Policy" dated 29 December 2022.

The President of Silpakorn University, under the resolution of Silpakorn University Executive Committee Meeting at its 4/2567 meeting on 20 February 2024, has set up the Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Presents and Gifts from Performing Duties “No Gift Policy” as follows:

1. The Silpakorn University Announcement on Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Presents and Gifts from Performing Duties "No Gift Policy" dated 29 December 2022 shall be cancelled.

2. Executives, civil officials, personnel and employees of Silpakorn University of all levels shall refrain from accepting and giving all kinds of presents and gifts before, during and after performing duties that will result in corruption and misconduct

Moreover, executives and superiors of all levels shall be good role models along with supervising affiliated officials to strictly adhere to this Announcement.

3. Executives, civil officials, personnel and employees of Silpakorn University shall not seek all kinds of presents, gifts or any other benefits.

4. Expressions of congratulations or best wishes on traditional occasions should be done by signing in blessing cards or books, or using social media instead of giving presents or gifts.

Moreover, giving presents, gifts, or any other benefits according to ethics or tradition or to maintain goodwill, friendship and good relations between people can be done without violating the constitutional law regarding prevention and suppression of corruption, cabinet resolution and related regulations and should be done in a way that helps promote a good image of Silpakorn University.

This Announcement shall be informed and observed accordingly.
